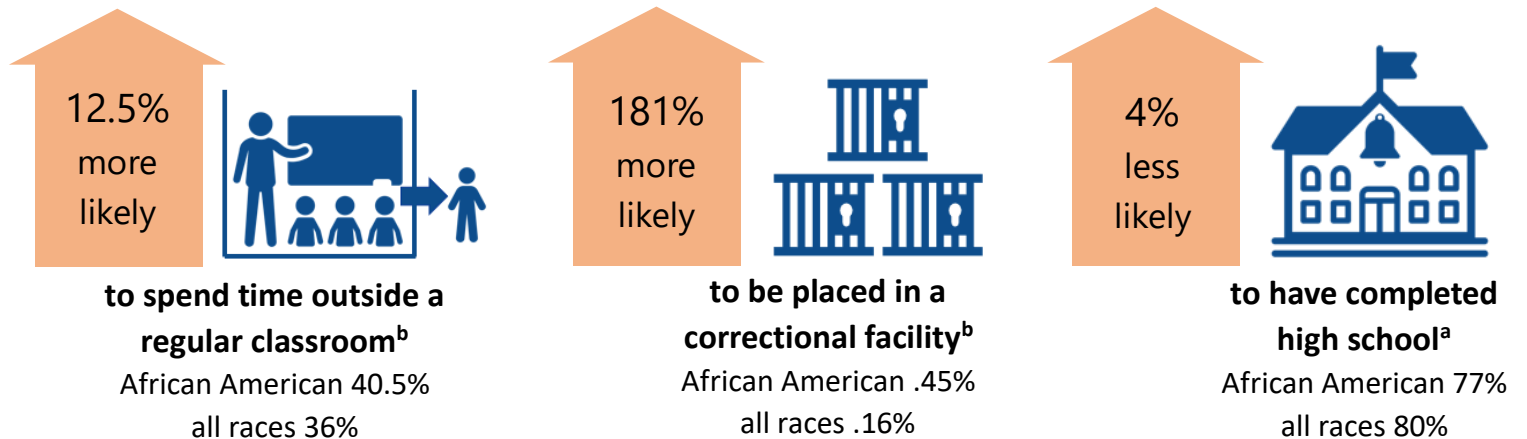
Disability Prevalence^a

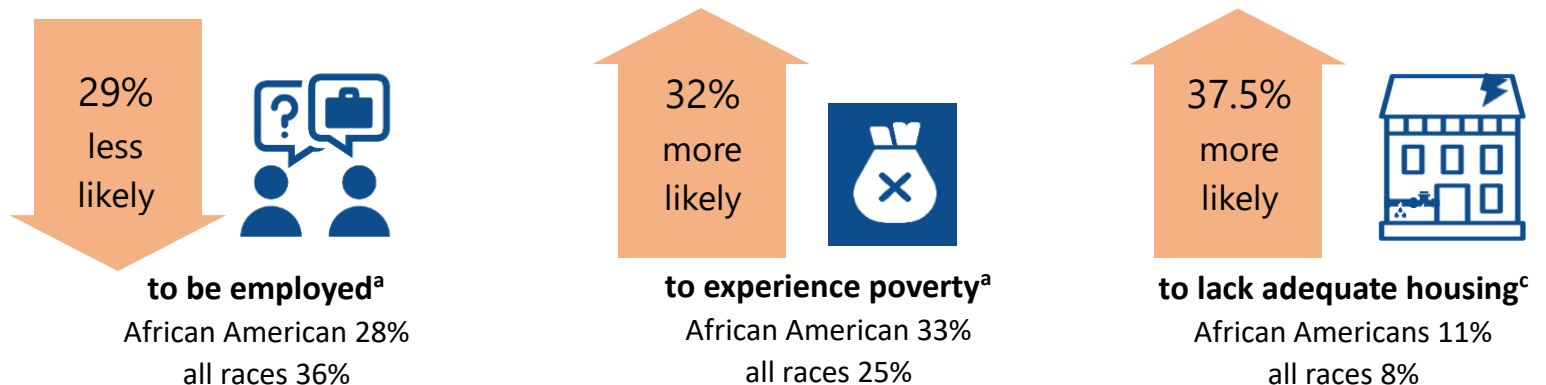
