## DEFINING PLACE

## Urban Counties:

Metropolitan counties: urban core of 50,000+ people

## Rural Counties:

Micropolitan counties: urban core of 10,000-50,000
Non-Core counties: no urban core ( $<10,000$ people)

## EMPLOYMENT

People with disabilities, ages 18-64, in the most rural places have the lowest employment to population ratio


1 in 3 children under age 18 with disabilities in the most rural places experience poverty
