# What is the civilian noninstitutional population?


#### Excludes people:

> in the Armed Forces




#### Disability rates by age






### A greater portion of people with disabilities are age 65 and over







### Labor force participation rates by sex, age, and disability status







# Labor force participation rate for persons with a disability by sex






### Employment-population ratios by race, ethnicity, and disability status






#### Employment-population ratios by educational attainment







#### Percent distribution of employed persons by occupation and disability status, 2012






# Percent distribution of employed persons by class of worker and disability status





### Part time for economic reasons by disability status





- Questions are subject to a detailed testing and approval process.




## May 2012 CPS Disability Supplement

- ➤ Temporary jobs




### Persons with a disability who were not employed, with a barrier to employment
